

Abstract preparation instructions for PSPA-13

The abstract must be written in English. It is limited to single A4 page (2.5 cm margins, top 3.0 cm). The title of the abstract should be typed using the 14 pt Times New Roman bold font. The names of the authors and their affiliations should be typed with the 12 pt Times New Roman font using the regular and italic font style, respectively. The title, author names and their affiliations should be centered. Please underline the name of the presenting/corresponding author and specify his/her email address using the 11 pt Times New Roman font. All parts of the abstract should be mutually separated by one empty line.

The body of the abstract should be typed using the 12 pt Times New Roman font and the text should be justified. Single line spacing should be applied in the whole document. Equations, like Eq. (1)

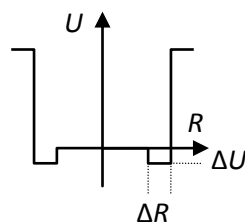


Fig.1. Figure captions should be typed using the 11 pt Times New Roman font. Figures will be printed in black and white only

$$\lambda_{2\gamma} = \pi r_e^2 c n_e, \quad (1)$$

should be edited by the Microsoft (MS) equation editor or converted to a good quality graphics. Included tables (Table 1), figures (Fig. 1) should be clearly separated from the text. References [1] should be placed at the end of abstract separated by one empty line.

Table 1. Table captions should be typed using the 11 pt Times New Roman font. Text in table fields should be centered. Horizontal lines only are preferred for table borders.
